RIGHT TO REPORT

If you, or someone you know, are experiencing sexual abuse or sexual harassment, Bureau of the Puerto Rico Police WANTS TO KNOW! WE WANT YOU TO REPORT RIGHT AWAY! Why?

Because

- We want to keep YOU safe; IT IS OUR JOB! It is your right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment.
- We want to conduct an investigation of the reported incident.
- We want to hold the perpetrator accountable for his/her actions.
- We want to provide YOU with relevant information and support services.

HOW TO REPORT

Reports can be made anonymously. Bureau of the Puerto Rico Police offers multiple ways to report sexual abuse and sexual harassment. Namely:

- Calling the number (787) 343-0000.
- Report to any employee of the Puerto Rico Police Bureau, family member, friend, staff medical or mental health.
- · File a complaint.
- Notify the PREA Coordinator.
